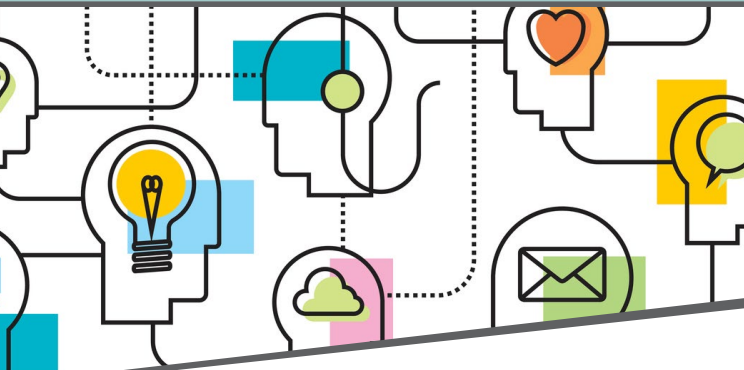




Leading Your Case: Opening Statements and Examination-in-Chief
